
Dear Brother Georgetti:

I am writing to you today to request a boycott be launched against Horizon Milling G.P., a grain milling operation that produces products under the name of Robin Hood. On April 25, 2007, Horizon Milling, a branch of the Cargill Foods empire, locked out 61 members of UFCW Canada Local 416P. The contract expired November 30, 2006.

Since the lockout began, the company has removed all grain stored in the elevator but continues to service its customers with products produced at other Horizon Milling locations. The employer is not prepared to negotiate a fair and equitable collective agreement. In fact, it last met with the union negotiating committee more than six months ago.

In support of the locked-out workers at Local 416P, I would ask the CLC and its affiliates to support a national boycott of Horizon Milling and Robin Hood brands.
